### **SECTION 4: First aid measures**

#### 4.1. Description of first aid measures

#### **▼**General information

In the case of accident: Contact a doctor or casualty department – take the label or this safety data sheet. The doctor can contact The National Poisons Information Service (dial 111, 24 h service).
